



## KING AND QUEEN OF THE IRISH

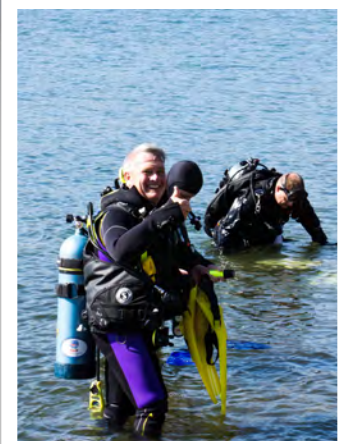
